It also includes a comprehensive study of Turkish affixes (derivational, inflectional, verbal, voice, and copula suffixes), methods of word derivation, and the rules of word stress. The second part focuses on orthography (spelling), covering the historical use of Turkic alphabets, the importance of spelling, specific rules for writing certain words and affixes ("ile," "imek," "-ki" vs. "ki," "-de" vs. "de," verbals), and general rules for capitalization, writing numbers, dates, proper nouns (Sun, Moon, planets), compound words, idioms, proverbs, reduplications, and intensified words, concluding with practical spelling exercises and applications.
